### Our Mission:

- To provide qualified umpires at all levels to our softball clients throughout the Region of Waterloo by promoting the development of umpires via the Softball Canada program.

### How to Join Our Association? Below are some guidelines:

- All KWUA new umpire applications must be submitted by May 31 for the umpire to be assigned games in the regular rotation. If any applications are submitted after this date, the umpire will be assigned games as opportunities become available.
- Please download the personal information sheet that is available on our website [www.kwumpires.ca](http://www.kwumpires.ca)
- Forward the completed KWUA information sheet to the President and Vice-President via email. (*The current executive contact information is also available on our website. Click on the name and it will direct you to the email contact information.*)
- All KWUA umpires must be carded with Softball Canada and are expected to be dressed in the official Softball Canada uniform Powder Blue Shirt, Navy Pants and S.C. Hat or the alternate uniform Navy Shirt, Grey Pants and S.C. Hat. For League play, it is also optional to wear the Red KWUA Shirt. It should be noted that both umpires on the field must be dressed alike. Official Softball Canada attire is available at Home Run Sports [www.homerunsports.com](http://www.homerunsports.com)
- You will be contacted by the President or Vice-President to make arrangements for an on field evaluation to determine the level of ball that you should be capable of umpiring. The evaluator will present you a complete umpire package including contact information, KWUA Constitution, Ball Park maps etc.

# **Constitution and By-Laws for the Kitchener-Waterloo Umpires' Association**

**(Revised April 2015)**

## **CONSTITUTION**

### **Article #1 – NAME**

1. An association to be known as the Kitchener-Waterloo Umpires' Association (hereafter called the Association) is hereby established.

### **Article #2 – OBJECTIVES**

2. The objectives of the Association are:
  - i) To provide quality umpires to softball leagues throughout the Region of Waterloo; and
  - ii) To promote the development of umpires by encouraging their participation in the programs of Softball Ontario.

### **Article #3 – MEMBERSHIP**

3. Any person, who is a registered umpire with Softball Ontario, may apply to the Board of Directors for membership in the Association. Application for membership is on an annual basis. All memberships cease at the conclusion of each calendar year.

Membership shall be granted at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

An umpire will be entitled to vote at the meetings of the Association provided they umpired a minimum of seven games for the Association (in the past twelve months), are a member in good standing and have paid the membership fee.

All umpires must have registered with Softball Ontario prior to accepting an assignment for the Association. Game fees will be withheld by the Association until proof of registration is provided for the current calendar year.

### **Article #4 – BOARD OF DIRECTORS and EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

4. A maximum eleven-member Board of Directors including an Executive Committee consisting of a President, a Vice-President, Past President, a Treasurer and a Secretary; shall govern the Association. The remaining board of director members may consist of the six liaison officers.

The Board of Directors and the Executive Committee positions shall be filled by election annually at the fall meeting of the Association, by a majority vote of the membership present. The members of the Board of Directors shall remain in their respective offices for twelve months or until a successor is duly elected (or appointed, if relevant) to succeed them.

The Past President position shall be filled by the out-going President until such time as there is a new out-going President.

Liaison officers elected at the fall meeting shall assume their respective offices January 1 following their election.

## **Article #5 – BY-LAWS**

5. Such By-Laws as may be deemed necessary for the proper operation of the Association may be adopted by an affirmative vote of a majority of the voting members present at a meeting, and may be amended in accordance with Article #6.

## **Article #6 – AMMENDMENTS**

6. The Constitution and By-Laws of the Association may be amended on notice of motion presented at a meeting of the Association by an affirmative vote of two thirds of the voting members present at the meeting, provided that a copy of the notice of motion has been received by the Secretary at least 45 days prior to the vote on the motion, and that the motion has been sent to the voting members at least 30 days prior to the vote being taken.

# **BY-LAWS**

## **1. BOARD of DIRECTORS and EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

The Board of Directors and Executive Committee members of the Association shall be elected by a majority vote of the voting members present at the fall meeting of the Association and shall assume their respective office January 1<sup>st</sup>, and shall hold office for one year.

The position of Past President shall be filled by the out-going President without a vote but shall be acknowledged by the members at the fall meeting in concurrence with the election of a new President.

## **2. VACANCY**

Where a vacancy occurs in any office for any reason, a member of the Association shall be appointed by the Executive to fill the vacancy, and the member so appointed shall hold office for the remainder of the term of the predecessor.

### **3. PRESIDENT**

The President shall preside at all meetings of the Association and shall call special meetings at the request of the majority of the Board of Directors. The President shall call Executive Committee meetings and Board of Directors meetings on an as needed basis.

The President shall be an umpire with a minimum of 5 years' experience and have a minimum Softball Ontario on-field rating of Level 3.

The President shall be responsible for the liaison between the leagues (or teams) and the Association, and may appoint one of the Liaisons to fill the role of UIC for each such specific league/team that the Association serves.

The President shall be ultimately responsible for decisions regarding rule interpretations or protests brought to his/her attention.

The President, in conjunction with the Board of Directors shall resolve all matters of complaint filed by a league (or team), in writing, against any umpire of the Association.

### **4. VICE-PRESIDENT**

In the absence of the President, the Vice-President shall assume all responsibilities and duties of the President.

The Vice-President may be consulted by the President in regard to any protest or rule interpretation, and in the absence of the President, the league (or team) shall contact the Vice-President who may call upon an experienced umpire for assistance.

### **5. SECRETARY**

The Secretary shall keep a record in a minute book of the proceedings of all general meetings of the Association as well as meetings of the Executive and the Board of Directors.

The Secretary shall keep a record of the names of the persons attending meetings of the Association.

The Secretary shall keep on file the Rules of the leagues for which the Association provides service.

The Secretary shall ensure that each voting member of the Association receives (or has access to) copies of the proceedings of the meetings of the Association.

The Secretary shall maintain copies of the specific league rules for the leagues in which the Association provides umpires.

### **6. TREASURER**

The Treasurer shall collect and receive all money due or owing to the Association.

The Treasurer shall deposit all funds of the Association in a chartered bank or trust company approved by the Executive Committee of the Association.

The Treasurer may make payments out of the funds of the Association on cheques or orders drawn by him/her and countersigned by the President or Vice President.

The Treasurer shall keep books of accounts showing receipts and expenditures from which the balance shall be readily found.

The Treasurer shall invoice leagues as required.

The Treasurer shall collect fines by deducting from the fees owing to an umpire.

The Treasurer shall remit to umpires on, or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the following month, fees owing for the preceding month.

The Treasurer shall present an audited report of the receipts and expenditures as required by the By-Laws.

## **7. AUDITORS**

Every year, the Executive of the Association shall appoint two members in good standing as auditors and they will be charged with the responsibility to review the financial records maintained by the Treasurer and to prepare a written report.

The auditor's report shall be presented at the spring meeting of the Association each year.

## **8. COMMITTEES**

Committees of the Association shall be established at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

The Executive Committee shall set their mandate and duration.

A Committee may also be established by the membership by majority vote, at any meeting of the Association.

## **9. MEETINGS**

The Association shall hold a minimum of two general meetings per year, one in the spring of the year prior to the softball season, and one in the fall of the year after the completion of the softball season.

Emergency meetings may be called at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

Notice of general meetings shall be sent to all voting members at least 30 days prior to the meeting date.

Except as otherwise provided, at meetings of the Association, the votes of the members shall be in the first instance by show of hands, but any member of the Association may demand a ballot.

## **10. QUORUM**

30 % of the voting members constitute a quorum of the Association.

If 100% of the Executive Committee is present at a meeting, the meeting shall be considered to have a quorum.

## **11. FEES and FINES**

The assignment fee payable to the assignor shall not exceed 5% of the game fee, and shall be set by the Executive Committee on an annual basis.

Upon the completion of 7 games umpired on behalf of the Association, a membership fee shall be collected from the umpire as established by the Executive Committee on an annual basis. The current standing fee of \$42.00, is to be collected over a period of seven games (\$6.00 per game).

Full umpire prices for both league and fees can be found in Appendix B.

A fine, equivalent to one game fee, shall be levied against any umpire failing to report for an assignment within a reasonable time frame for the beginning of the game assigned. 50% of this fee will be paid to any umpire having to work a one-umpire system as a result of an umpire failing to report as assigned, and 50% shall be credited to the league (or team) as a gesture of goodwill on the part of the Association.



Upon acceptance of a schedule of games from the Assignor it is expected that umpires will attend at the ballpark prepared to umpire the games assigned. If an umpire is unable to attend at any assigned game, he/she is required to find a suitable replacement and confirm the change with the Assignor. A list of umpires, suitable for each of the leagues, will be provided to members along with their phone numbers. The Assignor will be prepared (upon the umpire's request) to find a replacement, and a \$10.00 service charge will be levied to the requesting umpire.

The Executive Committee has the right to suspend any member for improper conduct.

## **12. ASSIGNOR**

The Executive Committee shall select an Assignor for the Association. The Executive Committee shall negotiate a fee for services, and shall provide guidelines for umpiring assignments (See Appendix C).

The Assignor shall follow these guidelines and is accountable to the Executive Committee for all related actions and decisions.

## **13. DOCUMENTS**

All documents or instruments of every kind, except as provided in By-Law #6, shall be signed by the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

## **14. LAPSE of MEMBERSHIP**

All memberships lapse as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year.

If fees or indebtedness of a member of the Association remain unpaid for one month, the Treasurer shall notify the member in writing of the amount and, if the member fails to pay the amount due within 10 days of such notification, the Executive Committee may forthwith declare such a member expelled for non-payment of dues or indebtedness and the Secretary shall notify the member of such expulsion. Expelled members are not eligible for umpiring assignments.

## **15. RULES of ORDER**

The rules contained in Roberts Rules of Order shall govern the meetings of the Association in all cases in which they are not inconsistent with the Constitution and By-Laws of the Association.

## **16. Liaison Officer**

The President may appoint a Liaison Officer to serve as the Association's front-line contact person with a specific league or team. The role and responsibility of the liaison officer will include:

- Attend league meetings as required e.g.: Spring organizational
- Maintain a record of the league's constitution, executive etc.
- Determine special playing rules (if applicable)
- Determine other rules/requirements of the league or team
- Communicate the Association's procedures and requirements
- Ensure that a proper contract is approved (if applicable)
- Deal with problems arising (e.g.: complaints; protests; incidents)
- Keep the President informed of all protests, incidents and significant matters concerning the league/team, as they relate to the Association's commitment.

## **17. PAST PRESIDENT**

The Past President shall be retained as a member of the Board of Directors and shall also attend meetings of the Executive Committee and Board of Directors meetings.

The role of the Past President is to advise and consult with the Executive Committee with regards to the planning and direction of the Association and to participate as directed by the Executive Committee with the Association's operation.

The Past President's term of office shall be until the current President's term is ended and replaced by election or appointment.

## 10. APPENDIX C

# KITCHENER-WATERLOO UMPIRES ASSOCIATION

## *Assigning Guidelines*

This appendix is set up to describe the guidelines that the assignor should follow while employed by the KWUA.

### **Determining Ability Level**

Each member of the KWUA will be ranked by the members of the board of directors along with other senior umpires in order to establish the capabilities of each umpire. The rankings are as follows:

Group A: South Perth (Any League)

Group B: KFL

Group C: Ladies League

Group D: Minor Only

Group E: Peewee and Under

A '+' indicates the umpire is capable of working the next level if necessary. In order to advance from one group to another, an umpire may ask the assignor to be evaluated by an official Softball Ontario evaluator. After the evaluator determines that the umpire has the ability to advance, they will be gradually introduced to the new group by being paired with more experienced umpires in the new group.

The ratings list is to be kept confidential with only the assignor and executive having access to it. Anyone wanting to know their own rating can contact an executive member and it will be disclosed.

### **Contact between Assignor and Umpires**

At the beginning of each season the assignor will ask all members to complete a form that asks members to record their contact information, preferred method of contact, and any other necessary information required by the executive. The assignor will then use the preferred method of contact, as noted by the umpire, to make monthly assignments. Any last minute games will be sent out via e-mail and calls will be made only if time allows. The assignor will then wait as long as possible for responses, then assess who would best fit the opening based on the ability and prior assignments of the umpires.

### **Regular Assignments**

The following will be the process by which regular assignments will be made:

- Games will be scheduled a month at a time when possible
- All umpires will receive a maximum of 2 nights a week during the first round of assignment
- All other games will be given out via e-mail and calls when possible. These games will not be assigned on a first come first serve basis, but rather based on the ability and other assignments of the umpires whenever time permits.
- Umpire must provide written or email confirmation of accepted assignments within 24 hours of the original email or the game will be reassigned. If email is not possible then a voice mail is required so that confirmation can be documented.

## **Playoff Assignments**

Playoff games will be given to the top available umpire based on the ratings scale developed by the board of directors.

## **Cancelled Games**

The assignor will continue to do the best he/she can to contact umpires via phone when they become aware the game has been cancelled by a team/city.

## **Umpire Changes**

If the umpire has a situation in which they are unable to work their assigned games then they are required to find a replacement on their own. A members list with phone numbers and emails will be provided to all umpires. Both umpires involved in the changed assignment (i.e. the umpire giving up the game and the umpire taking the game) are required to provide written or email confirmation to the assignor.

## **Umpire Absentee**

If an umpire misses an assigned game they will be charged a full game fee. The fine can be appealed to the executive if extreme circumstances have occurred.

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

**Q1:** How do I register with Softball Canada?

**A1:** Go to Softball Ontario Website and down load the registration form - <http://www.softballontario.ca/english/our-programs/umpire/registration/become-an-umpire.html>

**Q2:** Why do I need to register with Softball Ontario?

**A2:** To get insurance coverage when I am umpiring.

**Q3:** What if I just want to umpire local ball only?

**A3:** The application form to register with Softball Ontario has the option of **local umpire only** at a reduced cost.

**Q4:** What if I want to umpire provincial or national tournaments?

**A4:** Must be fully carded per deadlines designated on Softball Ontario Website. You must submit an application for the level you are qualified to do.

**Q5:** How do I become a Carded Umpire?

**A5:** Must complete the Softball Canada exam.

**Q6:** How do I advanced levels?

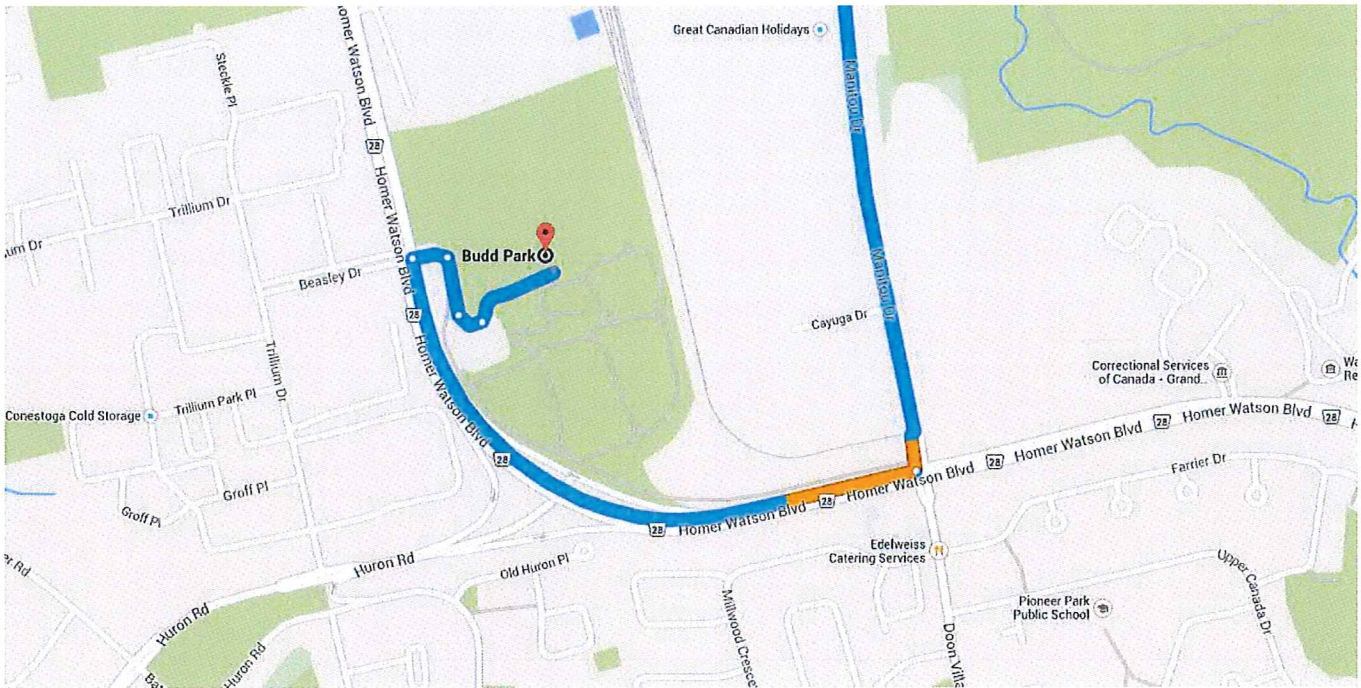
**A6:** Must attend clinics and receive on field evaluations (OFE) per Softball Canada Guidelines.
